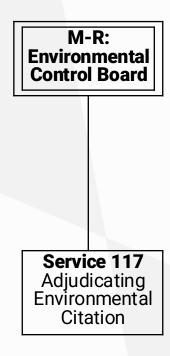

Fiscal 2026 Agency Overview

Environmental Control Board Mission

• The Environmental Control Board is responsible for providing an administrative hearing process for City residents, property owners, and businesses through the use of contracted administrative hearing officers. This service also educates residents on City code requirements, provides support and resources for local communities, and distributes grants for cleaning and greening projects. The primary goal of this service is to assist in changing behavior relating to quality of life and public safety issues that fall under the agency's jurisdiction. Key activities performed by this service include the adjudication of environmental citations, the adjudication of water bill disputes and Water-4-All denials, the offering of the diversion program, and the administration of the BMORE Beautiful peer-to-peer program.

- GOAL 1 Fill the new positions (Paralegal and Community Liaison) that are being created in FY26
- GOAL 2 Upgrade the Agency's document management

Service Description

 This service is responsible for providing an administrative hearing process for City residents, property owners, and businesses through the use of contracted administrative hearing officers.

Major Operating Budget Highlights

- A reduction of \$100K in State grant appropriations based on the citywide change in budgeting grants.
- A \$142,282 increase in Budgeted Pending Personnel Funding. This will be used to hire on a paralegal and to create a new Community Liaison position
- An increase in funding for Medical Insurance by \$34,870. This will fund costs associated with increases in medical insurance rates as well as providing medical insurance for the two reclassified positions.
